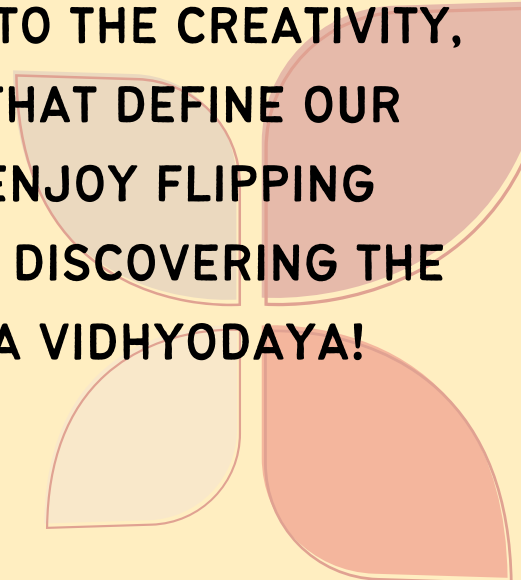

WHIZ KIDZ

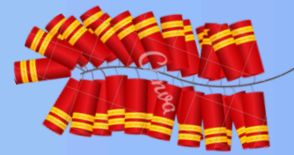

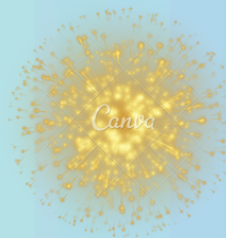




DIWALI CELEBRATION

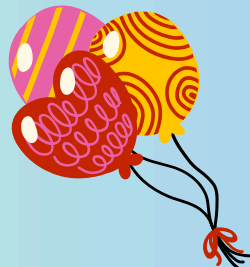

MIND MERGE

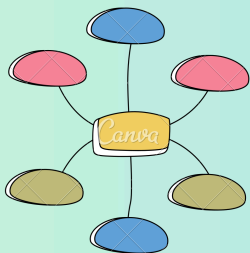

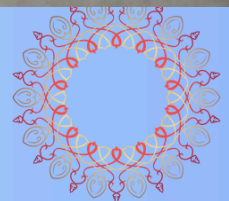




ORATION COMPETITION

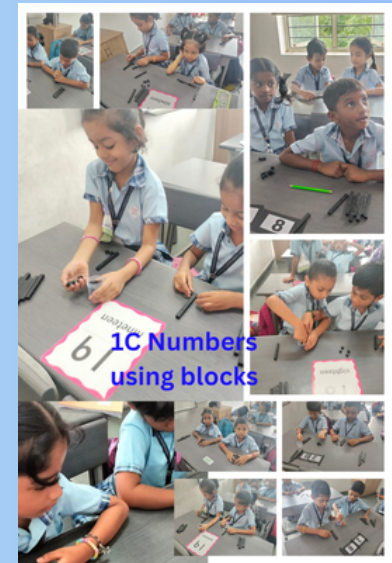
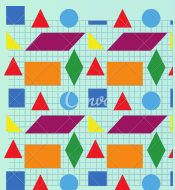
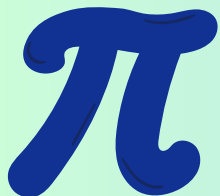
ABL RAMANUJAN WIZARD

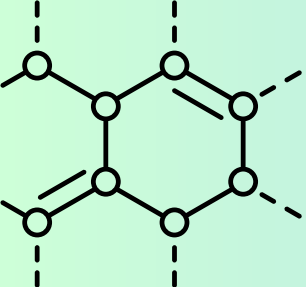


Our Ramanujan wizzard helps the students in having an idea of the practical utility of mathematics in addition to create their interest in Mathematics.

These activities are organized with an aim of integrating fun, skills and concept. The enthusiasm shown by our young artists was well exhibited through their creations.

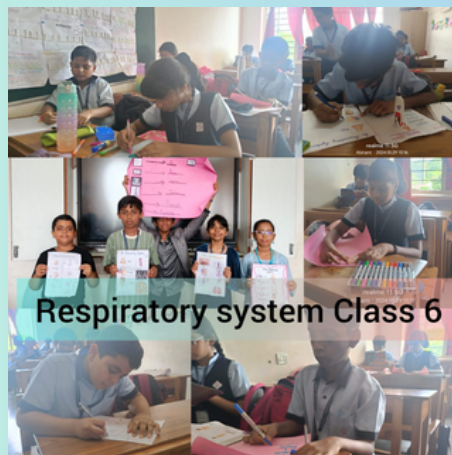

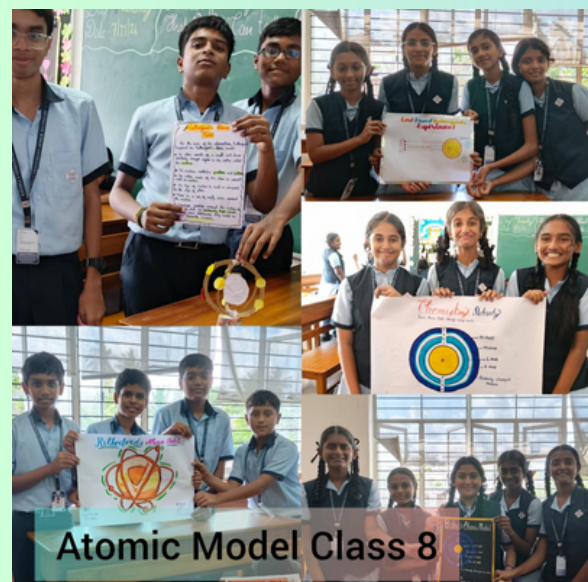
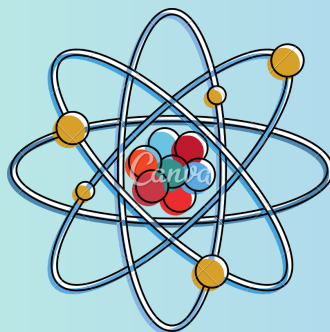


Exploring the Wonders of Science

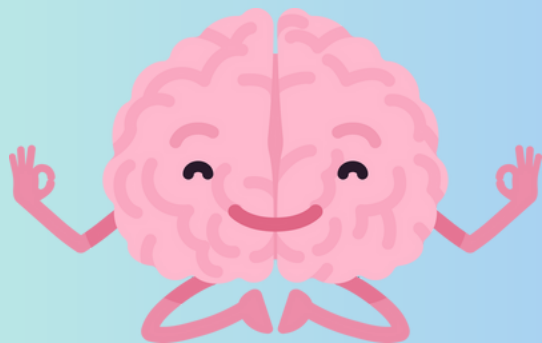


BABBAGE CLUB

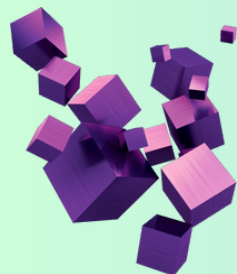
